Each Pair must have at least one wheelchair bowler using a BWBA-approved bowling wheelchair. It is planned that play will take place over both days of the weekend beginning promptly at 10am (please be report by 9am on Saturday). The finals will be played on Sunday.

Early stages will be on a round-robin basis (subject to entry numbers).

Dress: Greys below the waist for the round-robin stages and then whites below the waist for the finals. Coloured bowls shirts are encouraged but each partner in a Pair wears the same top.

The entry fee is £6 per pair, that is, £3 per person, unchanged for the seventh year.

St.Andrews BC will provide meals and refreshments throughout the weekend

Lunch Saturday : Buffet plus dessert (details tbc)

Lunch Sunday : Hot meal plus dessert (details tbc)

NB. There will be a veggy/special needs option if you want one BUT you have to let me know IN ADVANCE if you want this

Saturday and Sunday : Tea/coffee/biscuits plus afternoon tea/coffee/cakes

The prices are as follows:-

£7.50 per person per day will be the cost of lunch, teas, coffees, biscuits, and afternoon cakes.

£3.50 per person per day will be cost of teas, coffees, biscuits only (excluding lunch).

There will be a raffle over the weekend with the draw being made on Sunday afternoon.

Please also make sure that if any wheelchair bowler needs a pusher that you bring someone with you. If however you cannot bring someone with you then please contact Ian Blackmore ASAP.
